Word of the Day – Intolerant

Hi Everyone. Today's word of the day is **intolerant**. **Intolerant** means that you cannot tolerate or handle the way someone behaves or acts. It's a way to convey impatience. And a second meaning of intolerant is that you can't handle certain types of food. So in the first meaning of impatience I can use this word in this example

"The professor was <u>intolerant</u> of ignorant students who raised their hands to criticize his work. When they did not even have life experience and they hadn't even read his books."

So in this case the professor does not like and has no patience for ignorant students.

And in a second way, I can use this word to describe intolerance to food.

My friend has a gluten allergy which means that she has an intolerance to wheat. Any foods like pasta or bread, she can't eat. Also typically people have lactose intolerance or are lactose **intolerant**. So that means they can't drink milk or dairy. So I hope you can use the word **intolerant** to describe your feelings towards others or to describe your own food allergies or someone else's.
