In this way, thorough is often paired with the word "analysis" so **thorough analysis**. It means complete. Another way I can use this can also be complete or utter in the word **thoroughly**.

"He was <u>thoroughly</u> excited to see his relatives as he had been away at war for so long and missed them. "

So we often used the word thoroughly excited, **thoroughly ecstatic**, to express utter excitement, utter happiness.
