Hi everyone. Today's word of the day is **vivid**. **Vivid** means something to be clear. So clear that you can see it but actually **vivid** is usually something that isn't seen. It is something that is blurry like an imagination or your dreams or a recollection, a memory of some sort. But it's usually something you don't see that you're remembering in your mind. And here's an example,

"As a young boy, he had a wild and vivid imagination. Dreaming up what others thought impossible. It's no wonder he became an inventor."

So in this case his imagination is really strong so while no one else can see his abstract ideas or visions, his imagination is so strong that he can imagine his ideas becoming real. He can imagine a computer and actually create it. And here's another example,

"Several nights ago I had a vivid dream. I dreamt that was a millionaire and used all my money to buy ice-cream then went bankrupt. After waking up it really seemed that it really happened and from then on I decided to save money."

So in this case, my dream so was **vivid**, was so strong that it felt so real to me and this changed how I thought.
