Word of the Day – **Boisterous**

Transcript

Hi. The word of the day today is **boisterous**. **Boisterous** is an adjective, used to describe someone or something that is quite loud or abrasive. For instance you could use this word to describe an experience you might have had at a restaurant. You could say,

“I was so disappointed in the restaurant. While the food was delicious, the clientele was surprisingly boisterous. I could hardly hear myself think.”

So in this instance, the clientele or the other patrons of this restaurant were very loud and abrasive and creating a very noisy atmosphere. You can also use this to describe someone perhaps in a work situation. You could say

“While his resume was impressive and he could have been an asset, his boisterous manner would have turned away prospective clients.”

So as you can tell from this example, it is not a positive adjective and generally it is used in a negative sense and can be used against you.
