Hi everyone. Today's word of the day is **milestone**. **Milestone** is used as a noun, formally, and in a positive sense. The direct definition of milestone is a goal or an achievement, or a series of goals in a long term project. So if you're using it in your company, or your business, you can say this,

"The construction finally hit their first <u>milestone</u> in their 10-year long project, building the bridge."

So in this sense, you are trying to convey that this long project has hit its first goal. Because it's a ten-year project, there are a lot of goals in this endeavor. So by saying milestone, you are saying that you hit the first one. Another way you can say it is in your life. For example,

"It was an important <u>milestone</u> in my life in graduating from university."

So, your life is very long and in your life there are many goals. So if you want to say, "Hey, this goal was very important in my life," you can use it as a **milestone**.
