Word of the Day – Marked

Transcript

The word of the day today is **marked**. **Marked** is commonly used as an adjective or as an adverb, **markedly**. This word describes something that is distinct or noteworthy. You could use this word to describe someone's traits. For instance you could say,

"My friend has a <u>marked interest</u> in beer. While he generally is cavalier about most matters in his life, he always notes when a new brewery is founded."

In another example, let's say your friend has been studying English for the whole summer. She has not come to any social engagements, and you rarely see her without her books. After the summer, let's say all of your friends get together and she finally agrees to come out. At the party, you could comment to your friend,

"Wow, your diligence has really paid off. Your English is markedly better."
