Word of the Day - Exasperate

Transcript

Hi, the word of the day today is **exasperate**. **Exasperate** is most commonly used as a verb. This word can be used to describe relations between both family and work. A person or event that incites excessive aggravation or anger, something quite negative is usually described as someone that can **exasperate** you. For instance, if you were to use this in your day to day, if you have a sister that is always late, perpetually late; you could use it in a dialogue. For instance,

"My sister is always late but she had promised me that she would be on time. Can you imagine how <u>exasperated</u> I was when she was late again?"

Another example might be, if you're a student regarding a math problem. If you're having difficulties redoing the math problem and you've been trying to solve it multiple times and you're still finding it difficult, you might be **exasperated**. So again, for instance you could say,

"I can never figure out that math problem, no matter how many times I try. It's so exasperating."
