Hi. The word of the day today is **novice**. **Novice** is used as a noun. **Novice** is used to describe someone who is completely new at something. So someone who's never done an event or kind of work before is described as a **novice**. For instance, if you are new at playing a board game or a card game you can say to your friend,

"I'm a <u>novice</u> at this game. Do you mind walking through with me the rules and anything else I might need to play this game?"

You can also use this when you're describing a dance or a kind of work that you've never tried before. If you were to use this as a dialogue regarding dance, you can say to your partner,

"I'm a <u>novice</u> dancer. Those steps look kind of tricky. Can we use that move a little slower this time?"
