Hi. The word of the day, today, is **incessant**. **Incessant** is an adjective. This word is used to describe an event or action that continues with no breaks, something that is constant. So for instance you might have a child that is very eager to practice and you advocate that she practices as often as she'd like but it might be a loud instrument, so something like a trumpet or a piano. So you could say in conversation,

"While we advocate that she practices often, the neighbors are complaining about the <u>incessant</u> noise."

Another time that you could use this word is perhaps to describe traffic, which we all know can be quite annoying and can be quite loud and can really cause havoc in the day to day in getting to work on time.

"The incessant traffic is really causing a problem for our employees."
