summary

Namyang, one of Korea's leading dairy product companies, is under heavy fire after a recorded telephone call between its salesman and a local distributer was released on the Internet. The recorded conservation shows the Namyang salesman insulting and pressuring the distributor to purchase more goods despite being already overburdened with remaining stock. The exposed, strong-arm sales have caused public outrage over the way the company treats small business owners and has shown the high-pressure tactics to be a wide-spread problem within the company. Other victimized store owners have now come forward saying they were also forced to pay kickbacks to salesmen during holidays or when senior employees retired.

More than 150 associations of pro-small business activists and independent store owners have called on Namyang to provide full compensation for the **material and emotional damage** over the years, with some 6 million stores pledging to **boycott their products**. Following the public relations disaster, Namyang's CEO and representatives have made formal apologies. The company added that the salesman in question has been fired and that it would be revising its sales polices. Namyang's product sales along with its stock price has **plunged** due to the public backlash. Many experts say the Namyang scandal is **not an isolated incident** but more of a long-standing symptom of Korea's gap-eul relationship.
