- 1. **With credit to** Obamacare, healthcare costs have been rising **at the slowest rate** in 50 years and there are now **fewer Americans who are uninsured** than ever before.
 - = Thanks to the Affordable Care Act, the rise in the price of health insurance **hasn't been slower** in half a century and the US now has the most Americans insured in its history.
- 2. Millions of jobs have been **added to the workforce** since the start of the administration, putting the jobless rate below the historical **median** and at a 10-year low.
 - = Millions more Americans are employed than when Obama **took office**, **sending** the rate of unemployment under the historical median and at the lowest in a decade.
- 3. **In a major win for** marriage equality, gays and lesbians now have the **federal right** to marry, as the result of a Supreme Court ruling that the **denial of such was unconstitutional**.
 - = In a huge leap forward for gay rights, sexual minorities may now marry and be recognized federally, as made possible by the Supreme Court decision that ruled any ban was against the Constitution.

부정적 평가

- 1. **Due in part to** heavy lobbying by the NRA, Obama has not been able to strengthen gun control or **curb** the amount of gun violence, **having seen** some of the most brutal mass shootings in US history.
 - = **To an extent** the result of a strong gun lobby, gun control is still weak and gun violence **at its most rampant** during this presidency, with more national headlines of mass shootings than ever seen.
- 2. Terrorist groups such as ISIS now have a heavy impact on world peace, which has come out of a **destabilized Middle East** and **cooling relations** with other big players.
 - = Extremist organizations like ISIS now **stand as a threat** to international order, arising from **lack of structure** in the Middle East and **lukewarm relations** with other major powers.
- **3.** Even with violent crime down by over ten percent, many **blacks who are feeling abandoned** have begun to **rise up against inequalities**, **sparking a new debate** about race and racism in the US.
 - = Despite the rate of violent crime lowered **by the teens**, a lot of blacks who feel ignored have started to **speak out against** injustices, causing a renewed discussion about race relations in the US.
