Summary

In a tragic accident in Gangneung, three high school students lost their lives and **seven were found unconscious**. Ten high school seniors from Seoul who had finished the Korean SAT took a trip to Gangneung and stayed in a guesthouse, where **they suffered from carbon monoxide poisoning**. The police investigation says that **a pipe was not properly connected to the heater, leaking an excessive amount of the odorless gas which was inhaled by the students**.

The story breaks the heart of all Koreans, but the news feels especially tragic for **adults who reminisce what it was like to finish high school and start the next stage of their lives**. They understand the **level of expectations the students would have had about their future**. The young students who lost their lives didn't even have a chance to **do only some of the long wish list of things most young people want to do**.

When a tragic accident like this happens in our society, we always hear the expression "**lack of safety awareness**." In this case too, people say **the students would be alive today if there had been a detector to check the presence of carbon monoxide**. **Improving safety awareness demands cost**, but that cost saves lives.

People's interest in travel and outdoor activities have been on the rise. We need to ask ourselves if we're fully aware of the importance of safety for everybody.

1. 학생들은 보일러에서 유출된 일산화탄소를 흡입했다. 보일러의 배기관이 제대로 연결되지 않아 일산화탄소가 유출된 것으로 알려졌다. The students inhaled a fatal amount of carbon monoxide leaked from the heater. The pipe was not properly connected to the heater and that's how the carbon monoxide leaked. / Due to a faulty heater and pipe connection, the students suffered from carbon monoxide poisoning. / Exhaust from a disconnected pipe allowed the carbon monoxide to fill the room where the students inhaled the deadly gas.
