성공한 사람들을 보면 운이 좋은 사람들이 많다. 물론 열심히 노력도 했겠지만, 운이 따라주지 않으면 아무리 노력해도 성공하기 힘들다.

- When I see those who are successful, I see luck as a **factor** than **pure hard work**. Working hard is important, but you **can't be successful without good luck**.
- Luck, rather than hard work, seems to be the **main factor** when I notice success. It is necessary to work hard but luck is the **deciding factor** for success.
- Good luck is the **key ingredient** for success. **Luck trumps hard work**.

성공에는 인맥이 중요하다. 누군가 내 능력을 알아보고 나를 끌어 줘야 잘될 수 있다. 자신의 능력만 생각할 게 아니라 폭넓은 대인 관계를 위해 노력해야 하는 이유다.

- You have to know the **right** people to be successful. Somebody who's more powerful and **better connected** than you are should recognize you and give you a chance. That's why you should work on **building good relationships with influential people**.
- The key to success is having the **right personal relations**. You have to have the **right connections** in order to get ahead in life. **It is who you know and not what you know** that will make you successful.
- Your **social network** determines how successful you are. If you are **close with people of influence and power**, they will be able to help you succeed in your career.

운도 중요하고 인맥도 중요하지만 결국 열심히 노력하지 않으면 성공은 없다. 운이 좋아 혹은 다른 사람 덕에 잠깐 성공할 수는 있다. 하지만 오래 성공을 이어가는 사람은 결국 스스로 끊임없이 노력하는 사람이다.

- Luck plays a part and who you know is also important for your success. But if you don't work hard, you can't **extend your success**. You can be successful for a short period of time, mostly thanks to good luck. But those who **continue their success** are always those who work hard.
- The **combination** of luck and who you know will determine success. However, you need to work hard on top of that. Luck may **bring you temporary success**, but hard work is needed for your success to **last longer**.
- Luck is **fleeting**. It will only last a short period of time. Hard work is **long lasting**.
