- If something comes along that has better pay, take it! There is no more job security in Korea. Working at a new job can expand your career skills and build your resume.

당장 연봉 조금 더 준다고 회사를 자주 옮기는 것은 좋지 않다. 아직 한국사회는 회사를 자주 옮기면 뭔가 문제가 있다고 생각하는 사람이 많다. 한 곳에 꾸준히 있으면서 전문성을 깊이 발전시키는 것이 더 안정적이다.

- Don't be fascinated by a job offer with a slightly higher salary. Still in Korea, those who change companies often don't give good impression to others. People would think that you change jobs because you have issues with your current employer. Staying in one company longer and deepening your professional skills are always a safer bet.
- Don't be enticed by a bigger paycheck. Changing jobs frequently is a sign that an employee is unstable and has problems working with others. It is still not socially acceptable to work for a lot of companies. Having a long stable career at one company will be better for you in the long run.
- The siren song of more money can be a bad career move. Employees with a high turnover rate are looked down upon in Korea. You should find a good company, climb the corporate ladder and focus on building your professional skills.
