- Unless your job is related to politics, you don't have to be too interested in the political system. Paying a reasonable amount of attention to politics is enough. Instead, we need to focus on our own jobs. All we have to do is to loosely follow the politics and just not forget to vote.
- We can keep politics at arm's length. Politics don't affect our daily lives. If your job is directly correlated with politics, then you should pay attention to what is happening. Voting based on the general ideas of politicians and laws is enough.
- Paying attention to politics is a waste of time. If you don't have any skin in the game, you don't need to be heavily involved in politics. You can be an effective voter if you passively pay attention to politics to stay up-to-date with what is going on.
